**MDP App**

Please ensure you enter all MDP App details into your phone after your match with the other umpire before you leave the ground. Do not wait until you get home to do it.

- 3-2-1 votes are the responsibility of both umpires
- Red Card incidents need to be supported by SJ25 Umpire Incident Report Form submitted by 9am Monday following your match

**Runners & Water Carriers**

A reminder on instructions from before the break. **Please note additional point highlighted.**

- Runners
  - Runners are to deliver a message and immediately leave the field
  - Runners who are “coaching” or loitering on the field are to be asked to leave the field immediately by the field umpire
  - If a second instance occurs field umpire is to pay a free kick against the runner for interfering with play
  - **SANFL Juniors Rules & Regulations allow ONE runner only. For any teams using a 2<sup>nd</sup> runner he/she is to be sent off and not allowed to participate any further in the match**

Field Umpires can order the runner from the field ground if they feel the runner is on the ground too much. (YELLOW Card initially. RED Card for a further instance in the same match)

- Water Carriers (Blue or Pink vest)
  - Water carriers are to deliver drinks only and leave the field
  - Water Carriers should only enter the field when play is at the other end of the ground
  - Water carriers are not permitted to act as a 2<sup>nd</sup> runner & deliver messages with drinks
  - Water carriers who are loitering on the field and not passing their drink bottle around to players are to be asked to leave the field immediately
  - Penalise as above for Runners

- One match per umpire per day (only double ups in finals in case of emergency)
